### For financial assistance in renting:

- Contact your local Housing Agency for information about Section 8 subsidized housing, which gives rental assistance to people with limited income. If eligible, you can rent a house, townhouse, mobile home, or apartment anywhere allowed by the housing agency. Waiting lists are long, so it is best to apply early. Housing information is in the Blue Pages under “County Government” (in the city it is under “Local Government”) where the most common headings are “Housing Authority”, “Housing and Community Development”, and “Housing Agency”.
